	The facility has shipped out 1631.04 tonnes of finished compost in this time.					
8	The amount of screening waste from the plastics bin leaving the facility in this time frame is as follows:					
	Screening waste- plastics bin- 149.02 tonnes					
	Screening waste plastics bin as a percentage of incoming source separated organics is 1.46%.					
	There has been 4 rejected load in this time period from the City of Guelph contaminated with blue box material.					
	Facility has been running, taking waste from the City of Guelph, the Region of Waterloo and Halton region in this timeframe.
