

The Corporation of the City of Guelph

By-law Number (2021) – 20600

A by-law to repeal By-law (2020) – 20497, being a By-law to approve the expropriation of land, being Part of Lots 72, 73 and 74, Plan 8, City of Guelph (Baker Street, Guelph).

Whereas subsections 5(3) and 6(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, require the Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the Corporation;

And whereas on May 25, 2020, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph (the “City”) passed By-law Number (2020) – 20497 for the purpose of authorizing an application for approval to expropriate the lands described in Schedule “A” to that By-law, in connection with the redevelopment project along Baker Street;

And whereas the City has since determined that the lands described in Schedule “A” to By-law (2020) – 20497 are no longer required for the redevelopment project along Baker Street;

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

1. By-law (2020) – 20497 is hereby repealed.
