### **GRCA COMMENT\*:**

The Grand River Conservation Authority (GRCA) has no objection to the proposed consent or minor variance application.

#### BACKGROUND:

#### 1. Resource Issues:

Information currently available at this office indicates Part 3 outlined in the circulated sketch is within the regulated allowance adjacent to the Provincially Significant Eramosa River Blue Springs Creek Wetland Complex.

# 2. Legislative/Policy Requirements and Implications:

The proposed lot line adjustment is located on the edge of the GRCA regulation limit and the minor variance relates to existing structures on the retained parcel. As such, GRCA staff do not anticipate any impacts to the adjacent natural heritage features as a result of these applications.

Due to the presence of the above-noted features, a portion of the property is regulated by the GRCA under Ontario Regulation 150/06 - Development, Interference with Wetlands and Alterations to Shorelines and Watercourses Regulation. Any future development or other alteration within the regulated area will require prior written approval from GRCA in the form of a permit pursuant to Ontario Regulation 150/06.

## 3. Additional Information/Suggestions provided in an advisory capacity:

This application is considered a 'minor' consent application and in accordance with the GRCA's 2021 Plan Review Fee Schedule, the applicable fee is \$430.00. The applicant will be invoiced in the amount of \$430.00 under separate cover.
