By-law Number (2021) - 20620

A By-law to authorize a vote from home service pilot as an alternative method of voting for the 2022 Municipal Election.

Whereas Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may on or before May 1 in the year of the election, pass a by-law authorizing the use of alternative voting methods that do not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

1. The use of a vote from home service pilot for electors who cannot leave their homes due to illness, injury or disability is hereby authorized, at the discretion of the Clerk, in respect of the 2022 Municipal Election.
