RE: Speed Limit Reduction Proposal

Dear Mayor Guthrie and members of council:

I am writing to say that I strongly support staff's recommendation to reduce speed limits throughout the neighbourhoods of Guelph and on certain arterials.

I have long supported a reduction in speed limits as a common-sense public safety policy.

We know from statistics that unfortunately a certain number of collisions will take place in the city every year. I read that the majority of automobile collisions are due to driver error, meaning that the city has a limited ability to significantly reduce the number of collisions.

The speed at which a collision takes place is one of the most important factors about the severity of injuries and the likelihood of serious injury or death. I am asking you to accept staff's recommendation and implement it as quickly as possible.

Enforcement will be necessary, but so will appropriate street design. Drivers generally drive at a speed that "feels" right, not the posted speed limit, so design will be important in guiding behaviour.

This is a good decision for our fellow citizens, in particular the most vulnerable such as older people and children, and also our pets and urban wildlife.
