Please accept this letter in support of the City investigating the Drill Hall as a potential arts hub.

Ed Video exists to foster the creation and exhibition of independent media arts. We are open to the public and anyone can become a member, take workshops, rent equipment, or take part in our engaging events.

We take that belief seriously. Since our inception in 1976, Ed Video has been involved in the development of over 7,500 independent productions, has produced over 3,000 exhibitions, and has provided over 50,000 hours of hand-on instruction. We work hard in and for our community.

The following stats are a little old (2015), but it is still important to note that arts and culture play a significant role in Ontario's economy. Ontario's arts, culture, and heritage sector represents \$23.8 billion or 4 per cent of the province's GDP and over 301,000 jobs.

The arts also benefit the social, cultural and civic life of Ontarians. According to the Ontario Arts Council study, *The Arts and the Quality of Life*, commissioned from Environics, a resounding 95 per cent of Ontarians said that the arts enrich the quality of our lives.

The arts matter to Ontarians too.


