

The Corporation of the City of Guelph

By-law Number (2021) – 20653

A By-law to impose user fees or charges for services or activities relating to Parking Services.

Whereas pursuant to section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (the "Act"), a municipality is authorized to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on persons;

And whereas for the purposes of this By-law, and as defined in section 390 of the Act, "person" includes a municipality and a local board and the Crown;

And Whereas the new and/or amended fees and charges that are imposed pursuant to this By-law were approved by City Council on December 2, 2021 as part of the 2022 and 2023 Budget;

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "1" to this Bylaw sets out the fees and charges of the City for the activities and services enumerated therein.
2. That, except where otherwise indicated in a Schedule to this By-law, the fees or charges imposed pursuant to this By-law do not include applicable taxes, which taxes will be added to the fee or charge, if applicable.
3. That, unless otherwise stated in a Schedule to this By-law, any fees or charges imposed pursuant to this By-law that are not paid when due are subject to a monthly interest charge. The interest charge shall be calculated in accordance with City practice at 1.5% per month (18% per annum) and will be added to the outstanding amount on the first day of each month, as is the practice of the City.
4. That, unless otherwise stated in a Schedule to this By-law, all fees or charges imposed pursuant to this By-law shall be non-refundable.
5. That payment of any of the fees or charges imposed pursuant to this By-law shall be made in Canadian currency.
6. That By-law Number (2020)-20548 be and the same is hereby repealed.
7. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2022.
