


Impact of Vaccination



- Unvaccinated individuals make up a disproportionate amount of our cases
- This is seen in spite of generally lower public health engagement by unvaccinated individuals and more relaxed public health measures for fully vaccinated individuals


Booked and Vaccinated 5-11s[OLD]

- WDG is estimated to have over 25,000 youth now eligible for vaccination
- 1,000 5-11 appointments were made in their first hour of availability
- More than 29% of this population has already received their first dose, or are booked at a future WDGPH clinic
- WDGPH scheduled appointments represent only reflect a portion of future activity




Booked and Vaccinated 5-11s[New]

- WDG is estimated to have over 25,000 youth now eligible for vaccination
- 1,000 5-11 appointments were made in their first hour of availability
- More than 35% of this population has already received their first dose, or are booked at a future WDGPH clinic
- WDGPH scheduled appointments represent only reflect a portion of future activity
- Over 5200 doses have been given to date



Where are youth being vaccinated?

- 5-11 vaccinations are happening throughout Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph
- Local Family Health Teams account for 68% of all
 5-11 vaccinations so far
 - GFHT accounts for 45% of all 5-11 vaccinations in WDG out of our Stone Rd Mall site
- 28 individual pharmacies have combined to provide 23% of local 5-11 doses
- The remaining 9% of vaccinations have been delivered through other outreach clinics




Third doses in WDG

- The importance of booster doses is increasingly recognized internationally, especially for individuals with certain health conditions, those more advanced in age, and those otherwise at greatest risk of exposure or severe outcome
- In WDG, more than 15,000 third doses have been administered
- Nearly 7,000 of third doses have been administered at a WDGPH Hub site, with another 4,000 administered through Outreach clinics
- Remaining third dose vaccinations have occurred at pharmacies and primary care offices

Third dose progress in 70+ population

- Over 10,000 third doses have gone to individuals over the age of 70
 - This represents 70% of all third doses delivered to date
- There are another 6,500 third dose appointments for 70+ individuals in the coming weeks
- Combined, this represents approximately 52% of our 70+ population as either having been already vaccinated or booked for a third dose

Our other third doses have been administered to those eligible under other
