The Corporation of the City of Guelph

By-law Number (2022) - 20686

A by-law to amend by-law (2021)-20649, the Procedural By-law, to allow for roll call voting at City Council and committee meetings.

Whereas Section 238 (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. c. 25 requires that every municipality pass a procedural by-law for the purpose of governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings;

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

Section 4.11 (g) of by-law (2021)-20649 is repealed and replaced with the following:

- (g) Members shall distinguish their vote by voting either in favour or opposed using an electronic voting system. If an electronic voting system is not available, or should the electronic voting system be inoperable, the City Clerk will call votes by roll call.
- (h) Prior to conducting a vote by roll call, the Mayor/chair may ask if there are any members voting against the motion, if no members indicate a vote against, the Mayor/chair can declare the vote carried unanimously. If a member does indicate a vote against, then the City Clerk will conduct a vote by roll call.
