

The Corporation of the City of Guelph

By-law Number (2022) - 20692

A by-law to remove Part Lot Control from Part of Block 223, Plan 61M-26 designated as Parts 1 to 75 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22164, Part of Blocks 223 and 224, Plan 61M-26 designated as Parts 1 to 77 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22159 and Part of Block 224, Plan 61M-26 designated as Parts 1 to 84 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22158 in the City of Guelph.

Whereas:

Section 50(7) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, authorizes the Council of a local Municipality to enact By-laws exempting lands from subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act (Part Lot Control);

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

1. THAT Section 50, Subsection 5 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, does not apply to the following lands for the purpose of creating the parcels and/or easements shown in Reference Plan No. 61R-22164, 61R-22159 and 61R-22158 only:

Part of Block 223, Plan 61M-26 designated as Parts 1 to 75 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22164, Part of Blocks 223 and 224, Plan 61M-26 designated as Parts 1 to 77 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22159 and Part of Block 224, Plan 61M-26 designated as Parts 1 to 84 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22158 in the City of Guelph.
2. This by-law shall expire on March 21, 2025.
3. The office of the City Solicitor is authorized to execute by electronic means the document requiring registration to give effect to Section 1 herein.
