I understood that there was a considerable voice of protest back a year or more ago when the proposal for a bridge from Emma to Earl Streets was first made.

At that time, I sent a detailed letter, along with many other residents, stating the reasons that this bridge is a bad idea:

4. The concern of Emma St residents for increased bike and pedestrian traffic in our quiet neighbourhood.
