A by-law to remove Part Lot Control from Lots 65 to 82 inclusive, Plan 61M-244 designated as Parts 1 to 36 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22208 in the City of Guelph.

Whereas:

Section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, as amended, authorizes the Council of a local Municipality to enact By-laws exempting lands from subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* (Part Lot Control);

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

- 1. That Section 50, Subsection 5 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, does not apply to the following lands for the purpose of creating the parcels and/or easements shown in Reference Plan No. 61R-22208 only:
 - Lots 65 to 82 inclusive, Plan 61M-244 designated as Parts 1 to 36 inclusive, Reference Plan 61R-22208 in the City of Guelph.
- 2. This by-law shall expire on June 13, 2025.
- 3. The office of the City Solicitor is authorized to execute by electronic means the document requiring registration to give effect to Section 1 herein.
