

The Corporation of the City of Guelph

By-law Number (2022) – 20726

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Guelph (the "City") amending the Public Off-Street Parking By-law to remove the Macdonell Lot from the inventory of Public Off-Street Parking Facilities.

WHEREAS by the City's Public Off-Street Parking By-law (1987)-12425, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph enacted a by-law prescribing the rules and regulations for the operation of specified gated public, off-street parking facilities as more particularly described in Schedule "A" thereof;

AND WHEREAS to increase the availability of short-term parking within Downtown Guelph, the Macdonell Lot, as defined in Schedule "A" of the Public Off-Street Parking By-law is being converted from a paid lot into short-term free public parking;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A" to City By-law (1987)-12425, as amended by City By-law (1995)-14945, is hereby amended by deleting "Macdonell Street Lot" and its corresponding legal description from the table of public, off-street parking facilities.
