I just came to know that local residents are being asked to provide input on plans for the Days Inn hotel property. I am along time resident of Harvard Road. I hope this is the proper avenue to make an objection to this proposal before the decision is made final.

To convert the Days Inn to a 520 bedroom unit at the southwest corner of Gordon Street /Harvard intersection at 785 Gordon, the current Days Inn, is a traffic disaster with absolutely no thought in planning considering the present and future growth in population of Guelph.

Especially with regard to this junction just yesterday there was a collision right at the junction in front of Barbers Estate. That intersection draws traffic from Barbers Estate Residents who can go straight into Harvard or do a left and right on to Gordon, in addition to the oncoming and out going Harvard and Gordon traffic. With the September new university students, the traffic at this junction coming in and out of Shakespeares and No Frills Grocery stores at the Harvard Estates is multiple accidents just waiting to happen.

Cars already go way too fast on Harvard Road not stopping at Stop Signs that many residents have put up "slow down" signs especially at Harvard and Rickson.

The traffic of residents coming out of this proposed 520 bedroom unit at the Days Inn location will just bring a traffic deadlock for commuters, traffic accidents at key morning and late afternoon rush hour already existing traffic jams.
