A By-law to levy education tax rates for the year 2023.

Whereas The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph has been directed by the Ministry of Finance to levy certain prescribed education tax rates for each rateable property class;

And whereas the new assessment roll on which the 2023 education tax rates are to be levied has been returned revised pursuant to the provisions of the Assessment Act;

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Guelph enacts as follows:

1. The following tax rates as determined by the Minister of Finance for education purposes for the year 2023 shall be adopted:

Multi-residential	0.153000%
New multi-residential	0.153000%
Pipelines	0.880000%
Farmlands	0.038250%
Managed forests	0.038250%
Commercial	0.880000%
Commercial: vacant/excess land	0.880000%
Commercial: payment in lieu	1.102552%
Industrial	0.880000%
Industrial: vacant/excess land	0.880000%
Industrial: payment in lieu	1.250000%

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately.
