


Figure 1 - Detail from T. W. Cooper's Map the Town of Guelph, 1862 showing the south side of Alice Street as undeveloped. (Guelph Civic Museum)




Figure 2 - Plan 244 (registered c. 1846, Henry Holiver - Provincial Survey)




Figure 3 – Fire Insurance Plan of the City of Guelph illustrating the empty lot at 47 Alice Street, November 1907 (City of Guelph)




Figure 4 – Detail of Fire Insurance Plan of the City of Guelph showing the locations of the dwelling and shoe repair sop within 47 Alice Street in October 1929 (Guelph Civic Museum)
