At a recent meeting, City Council was advised that your building at 60 Ontario Street was encroaching on the Arthur Street road allowance by approximately 1½ feet.

I have been instructed by resolution of City Council to advise you that the City of Guelph acknowledges this encroachment and that such encroachment may be continued until the building is demolished.

Might I suggest that you file this letter with your Deed to this property in order that at some future date you dispose of this property and the encroachment is questioned, this letter then will serve to advise the purchaser that the City of Guelph recognizes and permits the encroachment.
