We respectfully request that the City of Guelph revise this year's bylaw review schedule to include a noise bylaw review.

We believe this technology is a viable and valuable tool for identifying and charging drivers who violate city bylaws and the highway traffic act by driving with illegally altered or modified exhaust systems.

Reviewing fines should also be considered as part of the review process. The City of Edmonton has recently voted to increase fines for first time offenders to \$1,000.00. A driver in Guelph was very recently ticketed for \$110.00.
