Splash Pad Final Concept Plan

Comments received through community engagement and from the AAC meeting in February have been considered in the final design.

The following are included:

- Large shade structure
- 2 accessible paths from parking lot and 1 connected to existing playground
- Accessible picnic style tables. Total number to meet FADM
- Seat wall within the splash zone to allow for inclusive interaction with water. The final number of seats to be determined through detailed design and in compliance with FADM



Splash Pad Play Zones

The splash pad will have three zones with age specific features in each.

Toddler Zone, Ages 0-4

- Bubblers and low sprays;

Child Zone, Ages 5-8

- Run through features, Rain features, taller sprays, spinners, action/reaction and collaboration

Youth Zone, Ages 9 and up

- Big sprays, dump buckets, surprise splashes and action/reaction
