ERO 019-7636 - Proposed regulatory amendments to encourage greater reuse of excess soil.

Summary

The Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks is proposing to amend the Excess Soil Regulation (*O.Reg. 406/19*) and the accompanying documents to exempt certain low-risk soil reuse projects from regulatory and planning requirements, and expand the opportunities for the reuse of salt-impacted soils.

Proposed Form of Input

Staff may prepare a letter for submission to the Environmental Registry of Ontario as part of this consultation process.

Rationale

The City has an interest in providing input on regulation which may affect the reuse of soil within the city.
