Culture at a crossroads



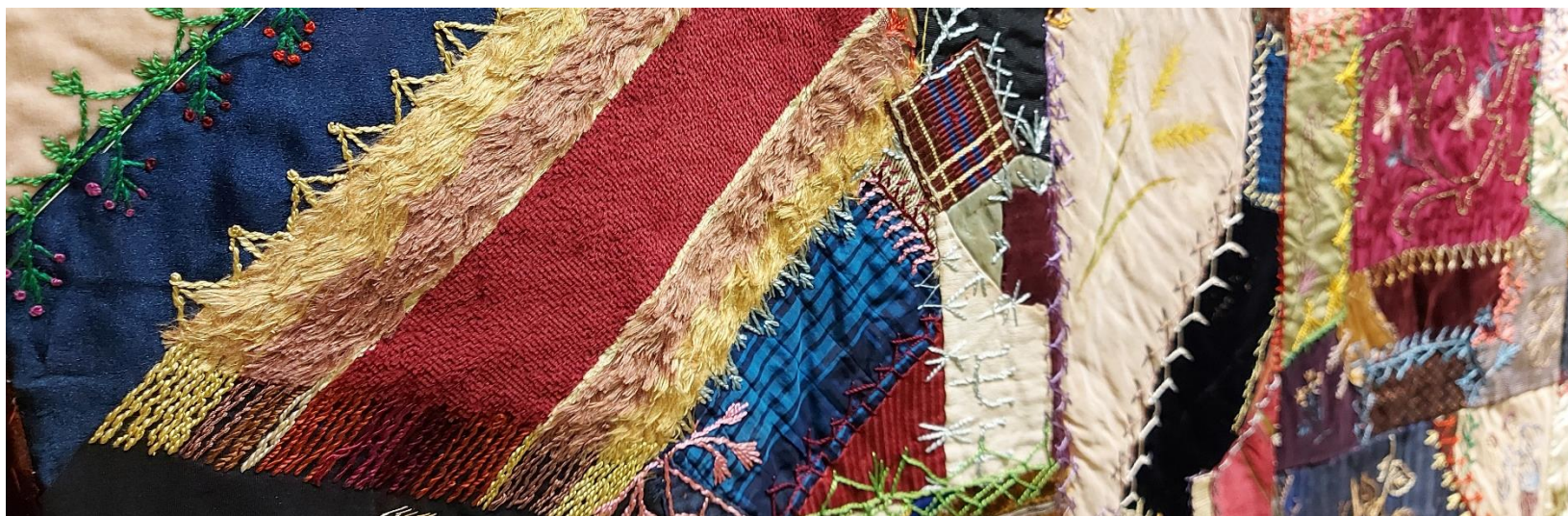

Mission



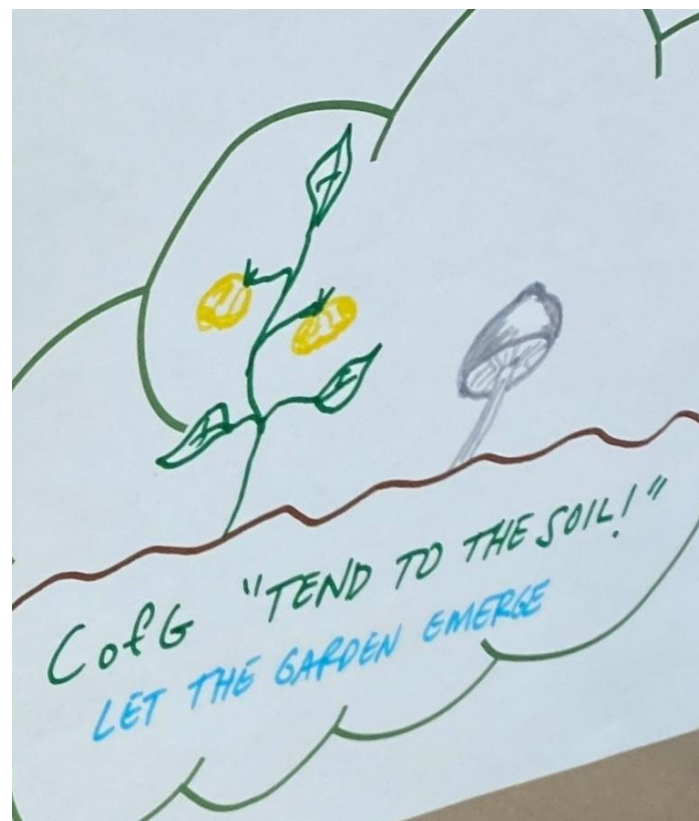
Working together – with a collective vision and collaborative effort – to support community vitality, equity and inclusion, environmental responsibility, and economic prosperity in and through culture.
