Thank you for meeting with myself and our Executive Director on October 11th following the Committee of the Whole meeting to discuss our concerns. As one of the largest seniors' organizations of its kind in Canada, and as your partner in running older adult programs across the City we respectfully propose the following amendments.

- 92. Continue work outlined in the Older Adult Strategy and implement seniors-driven initiatives while continuing to work with the Guelph Wellington Seniors Association to maintain Guelph's designation as an Age Friendly Community
- 93. Improve geographic distribution of older adult programs to ensure programs are offered throughout the whole city.
- 94. Continue to focus on existing Senior Activity Living Centres (Evergreen, West End) and investigate future designation of South End Community Centre
- 95. Update the City's Older Adult Strategy reframing as an Age Friendly Strategy to better align with current industry language and terminology to understand and support the evolving needs of older adults and ensure the city remains a great place to live and age well.
