Community Emergency Management Coordinator

Community Emergency Management Coordinator

- 1. The City designates the employee holding the position of the Community Emergency Management Coordinator as the Community Emergency Management Coordinator (the "CEMC").
- 2. The CEMC shall complete the training that is required by the Chief, Emergency Management Ontario.
- 3. The CEMC shall co-ordinate the development and implementation of the Emergency Management Program and shall also co-ordinate the Emergency Management Program in so far as possible with the emergency management program of other municipalities, of ministries of the Ontario government and of organizations outside government that are involved in emergency management.
- 4. The CEMC's responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to, maintenance of the Plan, training exercises, public education, and such other duties and responsibilities as outlined in the Act and in the Plan.
- 5. The CEMC shall report to the Emergency Management Program Committee on the CEMC's work under sections 3 and 4.
- 6. Three City employees representing the Guelph Fire Services, Guelph Police Services and Guelph-Wellington Paramedic Services are each designated as an alternate CEMC to act in place of the CEMC in the CEMC's absence.
