## PUSLINCH PIONEER DEAD

### Mr. James Hanlon, Sr., Passes Away in His 74th Year.

James, Hanlon, sr., passed away at his late residence, Puslinch, on Thursday last, at the age of 74 years. The deceased was born in the County of Carlow, Ireland, in 1830, and came to Canada with his parents in 1832, when his father, the late John Hanlon, took up his residence on lot 11, Con. 8, Puslinch.

The deceased lived on the old homestead all his life, and was very much respected by his neighbors for his kindly disposition, being never known to turn his back on any one needing help. He was ever the poor man's friend. In religion he was a devoted member of the Roman Catholic church.

The wife of the deceased died about nine years ago, and his son James died last April. He has left behind him to mourn his loss, a family of six daughters and two sons, also a sister, Mrs. Robert Cassin, and a brother, Patrick Hanlon, both of Puslinch.

The funeral will take place from his late residence, near the Brock road, Puslinch, tomorrow, at 2.30 p. m., to the Church of Our Lady.
