I fully support the decision of the Ontario Energy Board to end the gas pipeline subsidy for all of the reasons stated in the City of Hamilton's letter.

In reviewing our progress since declaring a climate crisis, it is clear that Guelph has not been taking it's climate commitments seriously.

Sending a message to the province in solidarity with neighbouring municipalities and in support of the Guelph citizens is a small step towards reestablishing our commitments.

Additionally the case for moving away from gas heating toward heat pumps seems quite strong.
