- Existing trails and cycling routes throughout the city
- Help people to find their way more easily:
 - plan their trips
 - estimate their travel time
 - choose the best route for their needs
- Public engagement through Have Your Say: Summer to early Fall 2024
- Engagement Summary Report expected November 2024
- Final strategy report February 2025

Recommendation:
