Subject	Public Space Use By-Law

On February 14, 2024 City Council considered the Public Space Use By-Law. At the time the matter was deferred, and is now going to be considered at the special Council meeting on August 28, 2024.

There is no new staff report, and so all relevant information can be found in the February 14, 2024 staff report: [Public Space Use By-Law, 2024-74](#)

The draft by-law as presented in February is attached to this memo and remains unchanged.

There were three recommendations contained in the February staff report; recommendations two and three were already passed by Council at the February meeting, so the only remaining recommendation that needs to be considered at the August 28 meeting relates to the approval of the by-law. The updated wording of the staff recommendation with current dates is as follows:

1. That City Council approve the draft Public Space Use By-law, as attached to staff memo 2024-359, and that staff be directed to place the by-law on the September 10, 2024 City Council agenda for final adoption after which the by-law will come into effect on October 1, 2024.
