In your written request for input concerning the above bylaw you state the following:

"...encampments cannot be set up within the following distance:

(b) within 10 meters of any ... area prescribed by the City as a sensitive public area (like our downtown square)...".

This very small area houses the Blacksmith statue and fountain, an historic statue which has been in place for over 135 years.
