


Figure 2: Census of Canada, 1881. Woodstock, Ontario.




Figure 6: City of Guelph Streetcar map, Heritage Planning Resources, 2024.

Figure 7: Fire Insurance Plan 1897 (revised 1907), Sheet 16, showing 350-354/328-332 Woolwich St.




Figure 8: Fire Insurance Plan 1897 (revised 1911), Sheet 16, showing 328-332 Woolwich St. and neighbourhood.




Figure 9: Fire Insurance Plan 1960, Sheet 16, showing 328-332 Woolwich St. and neighbourhood.




Figure 11: 1862 Plan of Guelph.
