Throughout 2024, the AAC has been instrumental in identifying potential barriers and advising on possible solutions to enhance accessibility within our City. Your dedication and expertise have significantly contributed to our efforts to meet and exceed accessibility standards.

# **Consultations and Engagements**

In alignment with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA), the AAC participated in numerous consultations and engagements. Out of 34 topics discussed at the AAC meetings this year until October, 25 topics exceeded the requirements of the AODA, while 9 topics were required under the Act.
