

A-32/25, A-33/25 variance application

Committee of Adjustment - the building in question abuts our backyards on Oliver Street. The original plan for this building, which we had no problems with, consisted of 2-stories and 2-units.

We have been unpleasantly surprised to see that it is now 3 stories, with a steeply-pitched roof rising to 4 stories, which means it is now towering over all other homes and our backyards.

When questioned why this adjustment didn't ask us for comments, we were told, because the area is zoned for this height that our opinions were **not** required.

Thank you for asking for our opinions on **this** re-adjustment.

We have no problem with **part a**, which would have a second story porch overlooking the street. We do have a problem with **part b**, which would have a second story porch looking directly into several yards, and in my neighbours' cases, directly into their homes. The privacy of both the Oliver street residents and the Alice street residents would be unduly compromised.

Please consider ruling against **part b and the rear porches**.
