# What is Asset Management?

#### What is an Asset?

An asset can be anything that is tangible or intangible that the City is responsible for or uses.

#### **Key Principles**

- The key principles of Asset Management are:
- •Providing required levels of service
- •Integrating asset management with corporate planning
- Informed decision making
- Accountability, responsibility & transparency
- Sustainability



### Asset Management Position







Phase 1 (core assets) & Phase 2 (all assets)

- Measure current levels of service (LOS)
- Understand cost to sustain current LOS

#### Phase 3 (all assets)

- Set proposed LOS
- Understand cost to achieve proposed LOS
- Financial strategy to fund proposed LOS

#### Total Value of the Core Assets

If the infrastructure assets that support City services were to be replaced today, it would cost \$7.7 billion, or \$50 thousand dollars per resident.

### **Conclusion & Next Steps**

- The City of Guelphs LOS Target = 10-Year Capital Forecast
  - Overtime, this means our target LOS are expected to decrease
  - The Target is to ensure the LOS do not decline further than what is forecast
- Need to keep investing and prioritizing our existing infrastructure
  - Our assets are aging, with an increased risk of failure
  - If the City continues reducing funding, the backlog continues to grow and sustainability will be pushed further out
- Continue maturing the AM Program
