

To Whom this file/application concerns,

A public meeting was held approximately a year ago with residents, the developer, city officials, etc. to discuss feedback on this plan. My husband and I attended this meeting and many residents, including myself had the following concerns that the developers and the City said they would address.

However, after seeing the Key Maps posted in our area for the above official plan (file OZS25-005) it looks like none of the following concerns were considered:

- Not enough street parking, especially during the winter months. It's already an issue with the 3 Gordon Towers at [REDACTED] Gordon Street.
- Reduction of retail spaces and the influx of population in a very confined area only adds to the growing demand on traffic, congestion and neighbourhood quality.
- Such high density housing will contribute to the erosion of the neighbourhoods sense of community.
- The small parkland shown on the map for such a large scale project is not in keeping with Guelphs "green" traditions. It should not be placed on a major roadway but by homes where people live. Streets do not need to see trees/grass...people do.
