I just have concerns about bringing 715 residential units in South end. There are many high rise buildings in area and not enough infrastructure for residents. There are too much traffic already and bringing high risers will increase it more. Also there are some safety concerns for children. Currently , cars driving on Poppy drive from Clair road , people drive too aggressive which put kids going to park safety at risk. There are no parkings anyways . People who live in Kay crescent buildings , Gordon square buildings , they park on streets up to the extent that there is no visibility even at the STOP sign . These increase risk of accident.
