Section 6.3.2.6.4 states: The Floor Area of a Licensed Establishment shall be located on the

First Floor only.

We are requesting a Licensed Establishment be allowed in the lower level.

Why is it not possible to comply with the provision of the by-law? (your explanation)

There is no ground floor space available in the Mercury Building as it is currently tenanted.

This variance would allow a new, small business to operate in currently unused space in a historic downtown building. This intent is supported by the 'Objectives to grow and strengthen the Downtown economy', Principle 3 of the *Downtown Secondary Plan*, as it reinforces and expands the role of Downtown; and encourages small and mid-size businesses to locate in Downtown's historic commercial buildings. The space is small and intimate with a total space and maximum capacity well under guidelines and would be a positive addition to the neighbourhood and the downtown core.
